Linear Antique still offers the same dual sided canvas appearance and is available in Grey, Sandstone and Salmon.

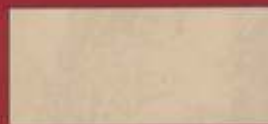

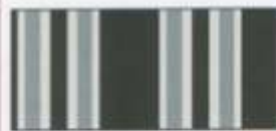

External awnings are an extremely environmentally friendly and efficient way to keep homes cool in summer and are aesthetically pleasing to the eye.

- They do not require fuel or continuing resources to run fans or air conditioning
- The most effective way of controlling solar heat is to block the sun rays before they strike the glass. (Internal curtains provide less benefit as the solar energy has already penetrated the glass and the absorption of heat has already begun)

- Close parallel awnings are rated the most efficient because they allow airflow but bar direct sun penetration
- Angled awning (inclined at 30-45°) block up to 75-85% heat penetration. This compares to even the heaviest curtains, which allow between 35-85% heat flow into the house.
- Fabric awnings are recommended, as they are less noisy than metal shutters or awnings.

HINTS WHEN CHOOSING A CANVAS AWNING

- Co-ordinate awning colours with house trim colours to make the awning a feature.
- Co-ordinate them with the main house colour (or garden colour) to blend the awnings into these surroundings
- Privacy requirements
- Look at the suns angle i.e. summer sun
- Placement of eaves
- Roof line
- Awning operating space

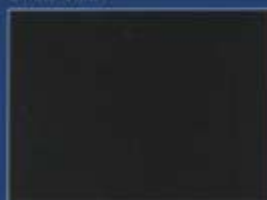

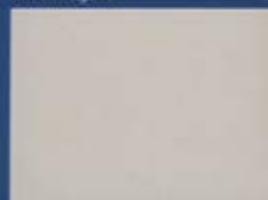

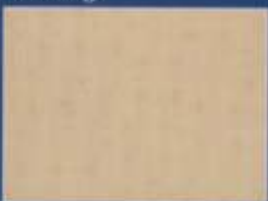
